# Violence Prevention Program

## Highlights

The Anti-Gun Violence Committee of 100 Black Men of Atlanta has reintroduced an awareness campaign to disrupt the culture of gun violence in Atlanta. To educate youth, conflict resolution and de-escalation training are key components of the program. Under the Georgia Power - Violence Prevention Through Mentoring Program, the Anti-Gun Violence Committee conducted more than 22 sessions of instruction. Each of the 22 sessions were between 1-2 hour in length.





# About The Event

On Thursday, February 16, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., 100 Black Men of Atlanta, Inc. will host a Violence Prevention Symposium at Clark Atlanta University.

The Violence Prevention Symposium was initiated by 100 Black Men of Atlanta, Inc. who have made significant, nationally recognized strides in Violence Prevention work.
