The 100 Black Men of Atlanta, Inc., founded in 1986, is a leading nonprofit dedicated to mentoring and empowering youth in underserved communities. As one of the largest chapters of the national 100 Black Men of America, the organization operates under the motto “What They See is What They’ll Be,” emphasizing the importance of positive role models. Its programs, including Project Success and the Collegiate 100, provide scholarships, mentoring, and leadership development to students from middle school through college. In addition to its focus on education, the organization engages in initiatives promoting health, wellness, and economic empowerment, as well as advocating for public policy changes that benefit the African American community. By addressing these areas, the 100 Black Men of Atlanta creates meaningful opportunities and supports pathways to success for youth and their families.

Emerging 100® of Atlanta

The Emerging 100 of Atlanta is the official young professional auxiliary of the 100 Black Men of Atlanta, Inc. It was established in 2010 as a group of high-achieving young men aged 25-35, representing a wide range of professional fields. The organization is dedicated to advancing the mission of the 100 Black Men of Atlanta by focusing on mentorship, community service, and professional development. As the flagship chapter within the 100 Black Men of America system, the Emerging 100 of Atlanta plays a critical role in fostering academic and vocational success for youth. The group primarily works with students from B.E.S.T. Academy High School and metro-Atlanta chapters of the Collegiate 100. Through its efforts, it provides mentoring, professional development, and community service initiatives, impacting nearly 300 high school and college students each year.

Collegiate 100® of Atlanta

Collegiate 100 are campus-based student organizations that assist 100 Black Men of Atlanta, as appropriate, with its programmatic initiatives that support the development of social, emotional, and educational needs of youth who need positive role models in the communities in which they live. The Collegiate 100 of Atlanta is comprised of representatives from local Atlanta colleges and universities, including Morehouse College, Oglethorpe University, and Georgia State University. The Collegiate 100 of Atlanta specifically teaches Life Skills modules, tutors Project Success Scholars and 100 Robotics Alliance participants, and numerous other community-based projects such as visiting and reading to senior citizens, community beautification efforts, and campus-based initiatives.
